Award Description

All teaching faculty (any rank) are invited to submit applications for the, “Innovation in the Franklin Multicultural Curriculum” grants. The goal of these awards is to support and encourage faculty to develop new courses that would be appropriate for the college’s multicultural curriculum (<https://osas.franklin.uga.edu/franklin-college-multicultural-requirement>) or to significantly revise existing courses in order to be included in the multicultural curriculum. These awards can also be used to engage in diversity innovation in the graduate curriculum as well. Three awards are available per academic year; \$2000 will be awarded for each.
